The fire department had 12 business meetings, 2 Officers meetings. Fire calls consisted of 1102 firemen responding to 1738 man hours. Calls broke down, Town of Rhine 843 man hrs and 623 firemen responding. Village 600 man hrs and 340 firemen responding and mutual aid had 295 man hrs and 139 firemen responding. The fire department had 46 practices, included in the practices are controlled burns, such as the dump, brush piles, chimney cleaning, fire extinguisher classes held at businesses , plus are regular practices. The department member ship is currently at 35, 25 village, 10 town of Rhine. Members retiring Dave Limberg, and Dave Bardon. One new member, Ben Mattson. Cadet member ship is currently at 3. Up coming events, Party for Marvin Weber having 52 years in the Fire department, April 14 2013.
